Welcome	This is a one page Sheet to tell you how the TeamSideline online Auto Coach Scoring Process works.
Scoring With Two Coaches	1 Game ends, so TeamSideline automatically sends an Auto Coach Scoring email to the Coach of each Team.
	2 Coach clicks the Score This Game link in the email to display a Score This Game page in the League web site.
	<b>3</b> On the Score This Game page, the Coach inputs the Score and clicks the Score button.
	<b>4</b> That's it you're done the Final Score will be posted when both coaches have submitted scores.
Different Coach Scores	! Sometimes the first Coach scores a game and your score (as the second Coach entering a score) is different than what the first Coach entered.
	• If this happens, the Score This Game page displays the contact information for the other Coach.
	<ul> <li>If you made a mistake, simply correct your score and click the Score button.</li> <li>If the first Coach made a mistake or you don't agree, contact your League Scorekeeper.</li> </ul>
Sample Page	Below is a sample Auto Coach Scoring email. Your League can configure Auto Coach Scoring to have 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> reminder emails sent automatically to coaches who have not scored games.
